

J – Last Branches (gentiles) grafted first back into natural trees vs. 127, 133



Tame Olive Tree = House of Israel vs. 31: "Mother Tree" vs. 117



A - Young & Tender Branches vs. 32 & 34; natural branches vs. 47; to be grafted vs. 37-39

B - Main Top dies vs. 34; main branches cast into the fire and burned vs. 36 & 41

C - Wild O.T. branches grafted in vs. 36-42

D - Natural Branches (young & tender branches) of T.O.T. "hid" vs. 48

...Long time passed away... vs. 49


E - T.O.T. bears good (natural) fruit from wild branches vs.52-57

> F - Lord of the Vineyard & Servant visit the Nethermost Part of Vineyard vs. 58-71

...Long time passed away... vs. 72

G – all sorts of fruit on T.O.T. vs.74; fruit all bad vs. 77; but root still good vs.80; wild branches have overrun roots vs.83


H - Lord of the Vineyard & Servant visit the Nethermost Part of Vineyard vs. 85-108



Nethermost Part of Vineyard "Natural Trees"


1st visit - much fruit vs. 66 2nd visit - fruit corrupt vs. 87


2nd - poorer spot than 1st vs. 65-66
